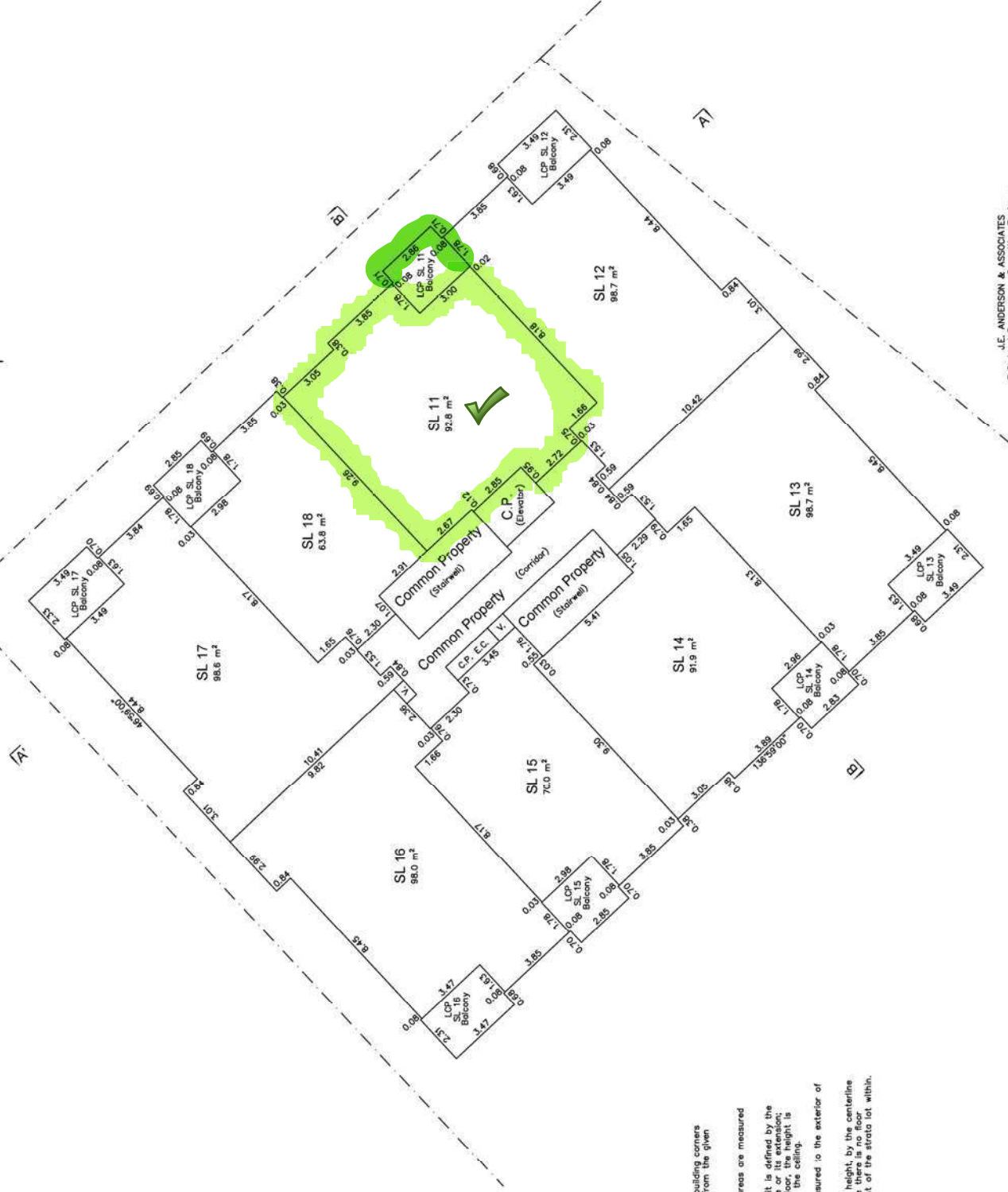


THIRD FLOOR

Unless otherwise noted, all building corners defect by multiples of 90° from the given reference bearing.

Strata lot dimensions and areas are measured to the centerline of walls.

The height of the strata unit is defined by the centerline of the floor above or its extension; or in the case of the top floor, the height is defined by the centerline of the ceiling.

Balcony dimensions are measured to the exterior of their floors.

Balconies are defined as to height, by the centerline of the floor above, or where there is no floor, above, by the average height of the strata lot within.
