This beautiful gated and fenced 51.68 acre ranch features a 2520sq' metal framed drive-through barn, a 1281sq' 5 stall equipment shed, a loafing shed with attached corral, a 9,072sq' equestrian riding pen, a 630sq' RV pad with water/electric hookups, water well & pump house. This property is under an Agriculture Valuation (exemption) to minimize property taxes. Paradox Ranch definitely defines a blank canvas. Relaxation from the city bustle sets in as you pass through the automated gate onto the concrete drive. Security, serenity and seclusion best describe Paradox Ranch. A few feet up on the right (pink flagging) you will see a natural waterfall feature and limestone pool. The owners have invested in a water retention dam to capture flow from the seasonal unnamed creek. Add a supplemental water well and a Texas Hill Country windmill for a perfect fit. Over the years heavy rains have allowed this grotto-like feature to create a natural water source for wildlife. As well as a peaceful place to simply meditate and hang out. Mid way up the caliche base road on the left (pink flagging) you will find a target alley and berm. This natural high bluff provides an ideal spot for target practice, plinking and rifle sighting. The road continues up the hill to the outbuildings and other improvements. Throughout the property are a variety of trees such as the Texas Oak, Live Oak, Red Oak and Texas Juniper. Whitetail deer, Axis deer, turkey and dove call Paradox Ranch their home.

Feel free to explore all that Paradox Ranch has to offer (utilizing the "LandGlide" mobile app and the provided Legend Map is highly recommended to make your way around the property). Experience vast views of Twin Sisters Peak and the Texas Hill Country from numerous possible homesites. The well-groomed ranch roads lead to several hunting corridors. Numerous hunting blinds and feeders have been set in place. Perimeter and cross fencing (pole and multi-strand) as well as swing gates run throughout the ranch. Miller Creek parallels the far west of the property line.

Paradox Ranch is situated conveniently to Spring Branch, Bulverde, Blanco, Boerne, New Braunfels and San Antonio. Just a short drive to HWY 281 and HWY 46 allow for plenty of shopping, restaurants, hospitals, entertainment and golf. The highly acclaimed Smithson Valley High School and Middle School are located within a short distance. Enjoy the waters of The Guadalupe River, Blanco River and Canyon Lake.
