1. NOTICES TO PROPERTY OWNER

If bills are not paid in full for the labor, services, equipment, or materials furnished or to be furnished, a mechanic's lien leading to the loss, through court foreclosure proceedings, of all or part of your property being so improved may be placed against the property even though you have paid your contractor in full. You may wish to protect yourself against this consequence by (1) requiring your contractor to furnish a signed release by the person or firm giving you this notice before making payment to your contractor or (2) any other method or device which is appropriate under the circumstances.

2. ALL INVOICES ARE DUE AND PAYABLE UPON RECEIPT

"Agreement to pay finance charge: The undersigned agrees to pay a finance charge on any past due invoices. Tom's Septic Construction will impose a finance charge if the total due is not paid by the 10th of the month following the date of purchase. The finance charge is computed by a "periodic rate" of two (2) percent per month on the unpaid balance. This is an annual percentage rate of twenty-four (24) percent of the outstanding principal balance, due as liquidated damages. Unpaid balance is the previous balance less any payments and credits."

"If bills are not paid in full for labor, service, equipment or materials furnished, the improved property may be subject to mechanic's lien." This means that any contractor, subcontractor, laborer, supplier, or other person who helps improve your property but is not paid for his work or supplies, has a right to enforce a claim against your property. This can happen even if you have paid the contractor in full.

3. ATTORNEYS FEES AND COLLECTION COSTS

In the event the purchaser fails to make payments as required, the account may be considered in default and the purchaser shall be responsible for the payment of all costs of collection, including reasonable attorneys fees, as allowed by law.
